We want to start by saying thank you to everyone who sent us a Christmas love offering. We are truly grateful and overjoyed to have received such wonderful gifts.

Bang! The New Year has started and we have already seen the hand of God moving this year. Currently the Lord has blessed us with 81 church bookings for this year, and we are exuberant to say that at the end of February we reached 68% of our needed support. We are moving ever closer to our goal of being finished with deputation by the end of this year and on the field in January 2023.

Throughout the months of January and February we had the privilege of being apart of many missions conferences. One of these conferences was with our home church (Florence Baptist Temple in South Carolina), where we were the final missionaries to wrap up the missions month emphasis. After the evening service, our home church held a beautiful wedding reception for us! Since Maria and I were married in Costa Rica in Dec. 2020, and due to Covid restrictions, Maria's immigration, and the busy schedule of deputation, we were unable to have a reception in the states. We are so grateful that our home church family put together such a wonderful reception.
